  - CMS issues with keying stewards reports; WM working through issues (ongoing)
- b) Two fridges died. Tested (30+ years old!). One getting replaced.
- c) Grounds cleanup continuing; Daryl to start earthworks soon
- d) More Porsche tyres arrived (thanks to Simon Rees)
- e) Website was hacked this month. Shut down and got it back up and running pretty quick. MS did a lot of work to restore the site to what it was.

### 13. Grants (GT)

a) Submitted application seeking funding for support of track extension

- i. Thank you for your significant contribution Greg and others!
- ii. Announcement not until August
- iii. Consultation: KA, gun club, council, minutes
  - Needs to be discussed with our members
  - GT seeks us to continue engaging our members (survey?)
- iv. Wanted to know what obligations we comply with
  - Compliance statement
  - Child protection act
  - We claimed an exemption due to Participant license (i.e. parent on hand at all times)
  - What are we doing as a club to minimize the risk to children
  - SGKC wants the state to pursue, all stewards have a minimum of a police check

**ACTION:** GT to research statutory requirement

b) BF: huge thank you to Greg for the huge effort! Greatly appreciated

#### 14. General Business (BF)

- a) Vintage Meet (AH)
  - i. Two-day meet (Fri, Sat). Visitors = Vern Schuppan coming out Saturday and Dean Canto
  - ii. Colin Moat has an old trophy (Dean Harrison memorial trophy); will be restored and used for the event
  - iii. Saturday night dinner in Training Rooms
    - Will get catering in. Cost TBC. Club seeking payment upfront (direct deposit into bank account preferred to avoid credit card fees)
    - Advertised on fb yesterday (18 yes, 16 likely, 10-15 others expected → 40-50pax in total)
      - AH: some may elect to pay on the day, but expect majority ok with electronic payment (think of the audience)
      - IWa: Pay through JK Tuning (given he has credit card option)?
         Discussed; prefer Treasurer email and bank account details. BJ to send to AH to advertise to vintage karters
    - AH to chase RSVPs, Club to organize catering
  - iv. Timing: transponders will be available for each kart, timing will run continuously
  - v. Friday will be open practice. Possible timing in the arvo.
  - vi. Saturday from start to ~11am is timed practice. At 11am start running multi-kart demos (~4x~10min sessions) good spectacle. 12-1 practice. 1:30 multi-kart display with past champions only. Followed by shootout. Followed by multi-kart display. Guess 3:30 at this time, ready to continue open practice. Close track at 5pm for celebrations in club rooms.
    - AH to send through details. Liaise with BF on trophies that make sense to award.
  - vii. WM will organize security for Friday night
  - viii. First Aid = Dave
  - ix. Microphone will be available
  - x. Canteen open from 11am Friday
- b) Tyre bundles @ Monarto
  - i. Peter emailed three weeks ago requesting returned as promised. He responded saying they will be returned but has not been actioned
  - ii. Proposed next steps:

- Another email saying they have until Sunday to meet the request, after which we will have them transported with a bill at their cost
- c) Security system review & upgrade
  - i. Agreed for the Executive committee to address and discuss at club meetings
  - ii. Due to confidentiality / sensitive nature will not be documented in minutes (which are uploaded to website)
  - iii. Looking into quotes, floodlights, sound alarms
- d) Supermotard guys want to come out and try the track
  - i. Fri 20-Apr proposed
  - ii. Income for the club
  - iii. They have their own insurance etc. We are leasing the facility to them (similar to schools)
  - iv. They have covers on pegs, handlebars, etc. to avoid damaging track surface
- e) **ACTION:** JG: to look at online calendar and ensure it says OPEN club day & get in touch with MR to fix as required
- f) SKC:
  - i. IWa: propose state invests in engines (4s, Js, ?) for come and try days
    - Will try and source karts afterwards
    - Will still need something for Cadets
    - Another option: IWi: at superkarts they give someone \$40 back on their next entry if they lend their kart for a come and try
      - State pays a lease fee to people who lend their kart to bring a mate?
    - Maybe we just do bring a mate at the end of our club days?
      - Doesn't allow for kids? Only seniors?
    - How can we streamline the Supp Regs process?
- g) AKASA website:
  - i. Very minimal advertising for local karting (e.g. not updated 7-Apr Barossa round, not the 8<sup>th</sup> per website...affected entries)
  - ii. Need to figure out who is control and how it can be actioned quicker / clearer **ACTION:** JG/ BF to query where website update requests are going / stopping?
- h) Timing at Bolivar
  - i. Tammy brought in to assist (everyone) as she has experience with MYLAPS (new timing system)
  - ii. It was not meant to be seen / interpreted as pushing anyone out
  - iii. There was no intention to make anyone feel unwelcome! There is no basis for some of the rumours that are going around
  - iv. It was understood that Sue Clee wasn't available for the first couple of race meetings; this was a misunderstanding as Sue was in attendance
  - v. We look forward to seeing all familiar faces again in the near future!
- i) Daryl grounds meeting
  - i. Lots of junk down the back...has to be sieved
  - ii. It looks like they moved the mound, put the posts in and added material to the mound and covered it over with dirt...lucky us!
  - iii. Clean up needs to happen anyway (even if track extension doesn't go ahead)
