



2019 Southern Go Kart Club Championship Structure & Rules

1) Competitors **must** be a financial member of the Southern Go Kart Club and will only receive championship points from a SGKC Club Championship race meeting whilst a financial member.

2) Race meetings that form the 2019 SGKC Club Championship are as follows;

- Australia Day Classic
- Festival State Cup (R2)
- Southern Sprint
- Festival State Cup (R5)
- City of Adelaide Titles
- Southern Spring Cup

3) Race meetings **EXCLUDED** from the 2019 SGKC Club Championship are as follows;

- Bolivar Historic Grand Prix 2019 (or any other historic race meeting)
- Any 'SA Kart Championship' round held at Southern Go Kart Club
- Any 'Rotax Pro Tour' round held at Southern Go Kart Club
- Any 'Australian Kart Championship' round held at Southern Go Kart Club
- Any other non-Karting South Australia or Karting Australia race meeting held at Southern Go Kart Club

4) A competitor **must** compete in a minimum of three (3) SGKC Club Championship race meetings listed above to be eligible for the championship.

5) Points are awarded based on the race meetings overall/final finishing position as recorded on CMS/Speedhive.

6) Club Championship points structure is as follows;

- 1st = 50, 2nd = 48, 3rd = 47, 4th = 46 etc.

7) If a competitor changes class (i.e. TaG Heavy to TaG Light) any points accumulated in the previous class **cannot** be carried over.

Competitors **must** satisfy all of the above to qualify for the SGKC Club Championship.

Presentations will be made at an end of year event (TBA) or, and no later than, the first 2020 Southern Go Kart Club race meeting.
