### Resumption Covid Fun Kart Practice Sessions.

The Covid restrictions have been modified as of Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> December. This will allow us to resume use of the track.

All attendees are required to pre-book their place. This needs to be done at least 48 hours prior to attending the track - longer is preferred. This allows the gate cards to be activated, a suitable COVID marshal and qualified steward to be organised to run the day. If you do not book, your card will NOT be activated and when you get to the gate- No ENTRY.

Bookings are achieved by completing this step:

1. Email [southernmember@southerngokartclub.com.au](mailto:southernmember@southerngokartclub.com.au) with your intended session time and date. Each application must include all names of those attending.
  - Remember- no booking means NO ENTRY!!

COMPULSORY Club check in procedure

1. Download the mySA GOV app on your phone in preparation for your visits to the track. More information and instructions for the app can be found here, <https://www.covid-19.sa.gov.au/restrictions-and-responsibilities/covid-safe-check-in>
2. When you arrive at the track you must use the app to scan the QR code for the club. It is a mandatory requirement from SA Health and is the only way in which we can operate at the moment. This records the date and time at which you attended the club and supersedes all previous requirements from KA and SA Health.
3. If you do not have the app you can use the camera on your phone to take a picture of the QR code and then follow the prompts.
4. Please take a screen shot of your completed check in. This will make it easier for the clubs COVID marshals to check your details if required.
5. This procedure must be done every time you enter the club. If you leave the club for any reason and return, even on the same day, you must re-do the entry procedure.
6. The use of the mySA GOV app or the scanning of the QR code are mandatory. This is a direction from both SA Health and Karting Australia and allows us to resume activities at the track.

The Club will maintain a register of all people who enter the circuit.

### Social Distancing etc

Please remember that we are still required to social distance and respect people's personal space. There is sanitiser placed strategically around the track for your use. Also:-

- There should be a clear area between pits (minimum of 5 metres).
- Attendees are strongly encouraged to bring their own hand wash/alcohol rub.
- No sharing of any equipment, tools or apparel.
- Under NO circumstances should ANYONE with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the circuit. This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of smell or fatigue.
- Under NO circumstances should ANYONE who has been overseas in the previous 14 days or been in contact with a known COVID-19 positive, attend the circuit.

Thanks to those that have taken the time to undergo some of the online officials training and been able to be the track official on practice days to assist in running the day and spreading the workload around a bit. The Officials academy is still available if any are still interested.

### TRACK CLOSURE SUNDAY 6<sup>th</sup> December
