

# SOUTHERN GO KART CLUB – BY-LAWS



## CLUB TRACK RULES

01. All members are to familiarize themselves with the KA Manual, specifically the classes for which they are eligible to run.
02. Any driver whose Licence or Club Membership has expired **WILL NOT** be permitted to enter the track to practice under any circumstance.
03. A Club members' gate card will provide them with access to the track for private practice any day of the week/weekend, except on Race Days, Controlled Practice, Working Bees, School Programs, or any dates as advised on the Clubs Website, Emails or Newsletter.
04. Practice times are:
  - a. between 7:00am and 8:30pm during daylight saving
  - b. between 8:00am and 6:30pm during normal times
05. The gate can only be operated with the card:
  - a. from 7:00am until 8:00pm during daylight saving
  - b. from 8:00am until 6:00pm during normal times
06. The gate will automatically open from the inside up to 30 minutes **AFTER** the completion of the practice times.
07. A member must have their KA Licence and gate card with them **AT ALL TIMES** whilst at the track to be produced if or when asked by an authorized Committee member.
08. A member must not, under any circumstance, give anyone else their gate card or allow anyone who does not have a gate card or KA Licence, access to the track (members' family excluded).
09. The gate must be closed at all times and any person or persons tampering with the gate in any matter to force it to stay open, will be sent a written warning.
10. All karts entering the track **MUST** comply to the current KA Manual, including be fitted with an air box, side pods, numbers and an exhaust system.
11. KA number plates must be fitted and display kart numbers for identification. They **MUST** be correctly coloured to comply with the KA Manual:
  - a. Cadet 9 & Cadet 12 – White background, Red numbers, 1 or 2 digits
  - b. Juniors – White background, Black numbers, 1 or 2 digits
  - c. Seniors – Yellow background, Black numbers, 1 or 2 digits
  - d. Practice / Social Licence holders must use the same colours but must be 3 digits

12. 'P' plates **MUST** be displayed by 'D' Grade, 'E' Grade and Practice / Social Licence holders at all times.
13. All members must never drive a kart on a licensed track outside of the current practice rules imposed by KA. This refers to Cadet 9 & 12 / Juniors / Seniors practicing at the same time.
14. All approved Safety helmets, gloves, driving suits and driving boots conforming to the current KA Manual **MUST** be worn when on the race track.
15. No unsupervised child under the age of 15 years will be permitted on the track while karts are practicing / racing.
16. All members must keep their children under control at all times. Parents / Guardians will be held responsible for any damage caused.
17. All members must never pit, refuel or oil their kart on any bitumen surface which includes the Track, the In Grid and the Out Grid.
18. Passengers are not to be taken on or in karts at any time.
19. The track is to be used in an anti-clockwise direction only, unless authorized by a Committee member.
20. Any person inside the track fence line while karts are on the track **MUST** be wearing a high visibility safety vest on their upper torso.
21. Safety Tyres around the track are not to be moved without the approval of the Executive Committee. They have been placed in position for safety reasons. If they are moved due to a collision, they are to be replaced back to their original position.
22. The consumption of alcohol, illegal drugs or smoking in the pits is forbidden.
23. No driver shall be allowed on the track whilst under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
24. No person shall move any vehicle at the Club grounds who does not hold a Licence to operate such vehicle as issued by the Department of Transport or State Authority.
25. Members are reminded that there is 24-hour video surveillance in operation throughout the circuit.
26. Any breach of the By-Laws (Club Track Rules) will be dealt with by the Executive Committee.
